



Naan Bread Pizza for One

My family absolutely love these. We have a stack of shop bought naan breads in the cupboard - and everyone justs helps themselves for lunch. Quick and easy but very delicious.



Ingredients

1 shop-bought naan bread

2 teaspoons tomato pulp (chopped and sieved tomatoes from a jar - or other tomato sauce)

1 cup of grated cheese and/or mozzarella

Various toppings to your liking: Mushrooms, cooked chicken, olives, peppers, tuna, spinach, chorizo, pepperoni, onions, cooked sausage, pineapple...

Method

Preheat the oven to 220°C/200°C Fan/gas mark 7/425°F. Lay the naan on a lined baking sheet.

Spread the tomato pulp or sauce over the naan.

Add chosen toppings and then cheese.

Cook in the oven for about 5-7 minutes, by which time the cheese should be bubbling and melted. Be careful not to burn your mouth. Enjoy!
